SMASF then gives those stories to songwriters and musicians who turn them into songs. That's where SEMS Wind Symphony comes in. Music is currently being written by a composer for a young boy who has battled cancer. Once complete, our Wind Symphony will practice the original music in preparation for its world-premiere performance at the SEMS Spring Band Concert (5/28). The boy and his family will be present at the concert to hear the song for the first time!
